PUBLIC NOTICE:

To all resident of Avoca regarding Parking Violations

The following violations (listed below) are becoming habitual and no longer tolerated. If not corrected by April, Code enforcement signs will be placed in your yard and a civil penalty will be charged; VIOLATIONS EXCEEDING 24 HOURS OR MORE, MAY BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE. Violators impeding traffic, safety or danger, may be towed immediately at owner's expense.

Parking vehicles across sidewalks	\$25
Parking in a NO PARKING area	\$25
Parking within 25ft of an intersection	\$25
Parking opposite to the traffic flow	\$25
Parking vehicles/recreational vehicles in the yard not on an impervious surface	\$25
Storing unlicensed and/or inoperable vehicles on property and not enclosed	\$25

February 20 brings **Presidents' Day**, a federal holiday also known as Washington's Birthday that is celebrated on the third Monday in February. (George Washington's actual birthday is February 22!)

ALL CITY OFFICES, AND DEPARTMENTS, AND LIBRARY, WILL BE OPEN. Trash Pickup is normal.

CITY OF AVOCA SNOW RELATED ORDINANCES



5.6 P Snow Emergency Parking: No person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned or leased off street parking area during any snow emergency for a forty-eight (48) hour period after cessation of such storm. The fine for this violation shall be \$25.

Remember, the City Code has long required that residents, landlords, etc scoop their walks as soon as possible after a snow event ends.



6.8 J Removal of Snow and Ice Accumulations:

It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours after being deposited, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax.

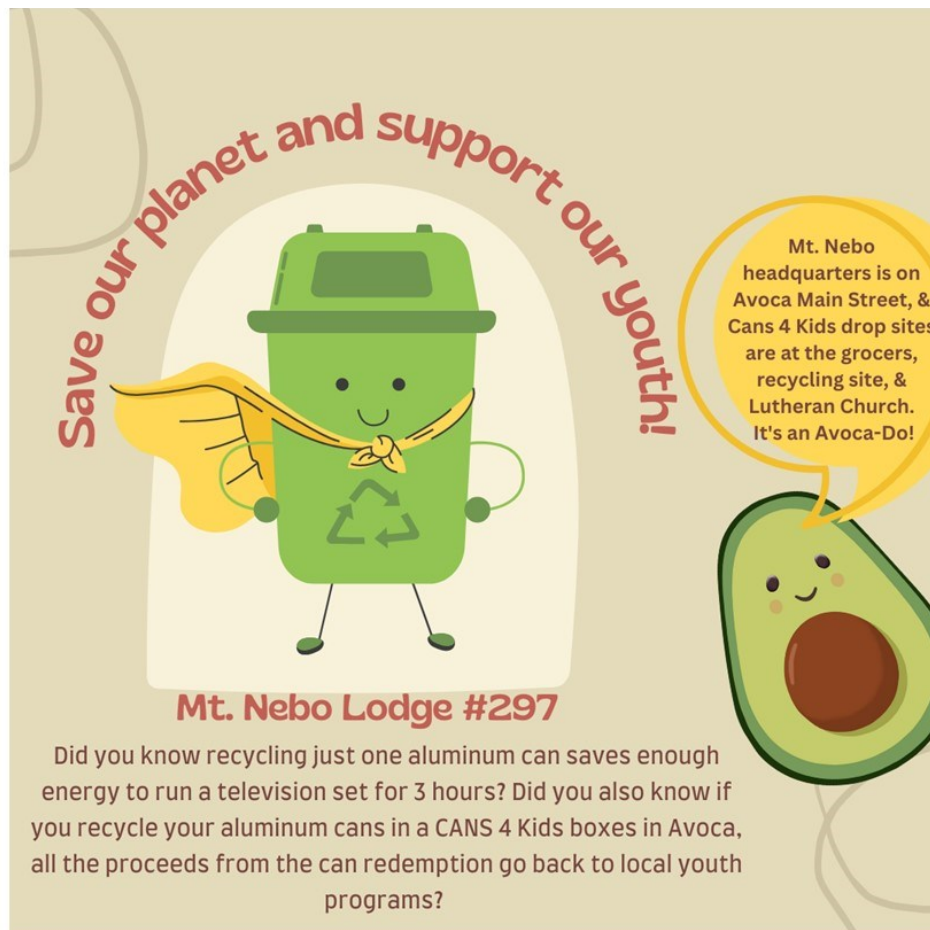
ATTENTION ALL LANDLORDS:
