Letters were mailed in December with a yellow highlighted return address. A completed application form and up-to-date rabies vaccination is required.

If your pet is no longer living with you or you have suffered the loss of your pet, please notify us and we will remove you from our records.

#### **MARCH Fire Prevention Tips**

March will be filled with windy, dry conditions that can fuel grass fires. Currently, Pottawattamie County is in a Red Flag Warning.

Two important factors in this determination are:

- 1.Relative humidity (RH) less than 25% for several hours. RH depicts how much water is in the air, relative to the temperature of the air
- 2. Winds 20 feet off the ground of at least 15 mph for several hours.





Chapter 4: Offenses Subject to a Municipal Infraction Penalty 4.1 Municipal Infraction Penalty.

A violation of this Chapter or the omission or failure to perform any act or duty required by the same, is a municipal infraction punishable by civil penalty not to exceed \$750.00 for the first offence and not to exceed \$1,000.00 for each repeat offense. Each day that a violation occurs or is permitted to exist constitutes a repeat offense.
