Council Meeting Avoca City Council, February 16, 2021

Mayor Aaron Long called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM with Diane Stamp and Fred Miller III present. On the Phone: William Dea. Due to the Covid-19 outbreak the City of Avoca held a phone conference council meeting with limiting the access of the Avoca Fire Hall. Motion by Miller, seconded by Stamp to approve the agenda. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Stamp, seconded by Miller to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following: approval of the January 6, January 11, January 14, January 19 and January 25 minutes, approval of claims, payroll, financials and bank reconciliation, approval of liquor license renewal: The Avoca Municipal Golf Course. Motion carried 3-0.

Mr. Wes Preston of Service Line Warranty gave a presentation via phone on service line insurance for water and sewer lines. Service Line Warranty is a vendor endorsed by the Iowa League of Cities.

The Fire Department has raised a substantial amount of donations to place towards the fire rescue UTV and slide in. Motion by Dea, seconded by Stamp to approve the purchase of the UTV from Holtz Small Engine for \$15,250.85 and Slide in water tank, pump, and hose set for the amount of \$5,850. Motion carried 3-0.

For proper maintaining our water tower. There should be an inspection at least every 3 years. Motion by Miller, seconded by Stamp to approve RESOLUTION: 21-0216-01: MIDCO DIVING AND MARINE SERVICES FOR WATER TOWER INSPECTION. On a roll call: AYES: 3, NAYS: 0.

Mr. Mitchell presented to the council a letter and pictures from one of the abutting land owners of the alley on S Oak St., Mrs. Tara Bordeaux. Motion by Miller, seconded by Stamp to set a Public Hearing on March 16, 2021 at 5:00 PM at the Avoca Fire Hall to allow abutting landowners input and council to make a decision at that time. Motion carried 3-0.

Fireworks display for the 4th of July: City Clerk asked the council for a rain date; Monday, July 5th at dusk. Council discussed and stated the quality of the show was good last year and we should request the same type of show this year.

Motion by Miller, seconded by Stamp to adjourn at 5:42 PM. Motion carried 3-0.

Mayor Aaron Long opened the Budget workshop at 5:43 PM.

The council listened to a presentation from Brocker, Karns, and Karns Insurance company, a vendor soliciting City business. Mr. Mitchell presented an overview of how the budget would flow with input from the City Clerk and DA Davidson. We will exhaust all Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) in the upcoming budget, so if we want to claim TIF the City will have to claim by December 1st 2021, preferably under the Sunrise Ridge development project. Also, our general fund has relied on TIF to supplement it. The City Administrator and department heads will search for efficiencies and brief the Council at the next workshop.
