Annual Pottawattamie County Sheriff Contract is due. Motion by Miller, seconded by Stamp to approve Annual Sheriff Contract with Pottawattamie starting July 2021. Motion carried 5-0.

Council is having the Sunrise Ridge Addition soil sampled to see if it will hold water for a pond. Motion by Stolz, seconded by Gramkow to approve the contract with Certified Testing Services, Inc. to do soil sampling for pond area in the Sunrise Ridge Addition. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Mitchell presented an update on our Culture and Recreation start up for the season.

Mr. Mitchell presented to the council that we have one contractor that has looked at the Legion Hall and another contractor will give a competitive bid for the roof. Continuing to make progress on a lease agreement for the Avoca Legion Community Center.
