Mayor Aaron Long called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM with Matt Gramkow, Fred Miller III, William Dea and Diane Stamp present. Due to the Covid-19 outbreak the City of Avoca council held a phone conference council meeting with limiting the access of the Avoca Fire Hall.
