Council had an asbestos inspection done at 509 N Walnut St. Motion by Miller, seconded by Gramkow to move forward with asbestos removal and put out a bid notice for demolition giving the contractors 60 days from the bid date and add removal of tree in the back yard. Motion carried 5-0.

Council discussed concrete dump fees at the burn site, will amend the ombious fee schedule at the March 21st meeting.
